Signing up for MN Responds

- Although it's labeled as being for "medical reserve corps," it's also a sign-up for MN Responds general volunteering.
- Try to complete the form in one sitting, without stopping, refreshing, or using the back or forward buttons.

Step 1 - Organization

- 1. Click "Add Organizations." A new window will pop up.
- 2. Scroll down to "Cook County Organizations." Click on the small + button to the left of the gray people.
- 3. Choose "Northeast MN Responds Unit/Cook County Program."
- 4. Click "Select" in the lower right corner.

Step 2 - Account Information

Follow the steps to set up an account in the MN Responds system.

Be sure to write down and save: your user name, password, and the answer to your secret question.

Check the "Terms of Service" and "Information Pledge" boxes, and fill out the name, address, and primary contact info. If you're going to be driving, be sure to put in your driver's license number.

Step 3 - Occupation Information

If you are not now, or have not ever, worked in the medical field, choose "Non-medical." From the drop-down field choose the options that most closely matches your background as well as your current professional status.

Step 4 - Registration Feedback

Choose from the drop down options. If your answer isn't listed, choose other and write it in the comment box.

At this point, a pop-up window about "DEPLOYMENT" will appear. You can ignore it. None of us are going anywhere!

You're now finished with registration and can leave the site. You'll get a confirmation email soon. Thank for your willingness to help!
